New and Old Business: Field Day

This year's Field Day will be June 23rd & 24th.

Breakfast will be on Saturday, June 23rd, 7:00 am at the Cracker Barrel in Kingsland. Set up will start at 8:30 at K-Mart near the Lawn and Garden Center.

Joe handed a sign up sheet to get an idea to see who would be there.

Field Day would last until noon on Sunday because there was going to be a go to radio for public use and test antennas. There was much discussion about what a go to radio was and who could operate it. Joe read from an article from a magazine that described what a go to radio was. Having a go to radio would not change the club's 3 Alpha classification for Field Day.

Last year, there were only about 200 contacts made. It is hoped that with digital being added this year, that number will improve.

Glen will have his camper and it will be set up for digital and side band. Tim's camper will be used for CW for Joe. Charlie will run the go to station. Bill will bring his diesel

generator that gets 60 hours on one tank of fuel. There will be five different types of antennas in use. There will be a 10x20 canopy tent for eating.

There will be a picnic at 5:30 on the 23rd. Pete will be getting the food. Glen will bring his grill. Everyone will bring their own non alcoholic drinks.

There are eight operators on the sign up list. Adell's voice will be recorded for the HF station and Shane will just push the buttons. Tim will send out an email to the club members asking them to attend. There will be an article about Field Day for the newspaper and there will also be a sign along side the road.

Kid's Day will be done if there is any interest. John suggested that a "thank you" card be sent from the club to K-Mart and Joe said there would be.

There was some discussion about traffic patterns and safety issues in the K-Mart parking lot. There will be cones placed on the roads.

Glen mentioned that the Albany club had a Field Day program written in Lynx. There will also be a band plan posted at each station.

Joe thanked Rob for the excellent job he did on getting the Club's brochures put together and printed. Rob submitted an invoice to Bill for payment.

Joe mentioned the Saturday morning breakfast at Cracker Barrel was not well attended this week. Just five people showed up. Assurances were given that these breakfasts were not meetings, just social opportunities.

Rob mentioned that he is working on setting up at UHF repeater at his house. It will be at 25 ft and on 443.025.

Joe will be calling the net in June
